國立臺灣大學自 1928 年創校迄今，即將邁向百年校慶。為支援研究、教學所需，校內各系所單位於學術研究領域內，廣泛蒐集各式獨特珍貴且豐富的文獻史料、標本與文物，並設立標本／文物陳列等館室進行蒐集典藏，為本校不可忽視的珍貴資產。

2007 年 11 月 15 日，臺大博物館群正式啟動，將早期的標本室與文物陳列館修整後對外開放。現階段成員館計有 11 個，校史館、人類學博物館、地質標本館、物理文物廳、昆蟲標本館、農業陳列館、植物標本館、動物博物館、檔案館、醫學人文博物館，以及美術館。

分散於校園各處的臺大博物館群成員館，突破傳統博物館單一建築物展示空間限制，將藏品與系所教學、研究環境及校園歷史脈絡相連結，形成臺大博物館群所獨有之特色。

As Taiwan's first major comprehensive and research-intensive university, National Taiwan University boasts nearly 100 years of history and a rich academic legacy. Since 1928, many unique and prestigious materials, specimens, and documents have been collected for teaching and research purposes. To make these collections more accessible to the general public, the NTU Museums network was founded on Nov. 15th, 2007. The network encompasses the NTU History Gallery, the Museum of Anthropology, the Geo-specimen Cottage, the Heritage Hall of Physics, the Insect Museum, the Agricultural Exhibition Hall, the Herbarium, the Museum of Zoology, the Archives, the Museum of Medical Humanities, and the Art Museum.



臺大校史館位於舊總圖書館二樓閱覽室，常設展廳於2005年6月22日揭幕，特展區川流廳則於2007年11月15日校慶日啟用，校史館由圖書館負責營運。舊總圖起造於1929年的臺北帝國大學時期，經歷五階段之興建與擴充；1998年圖書館搬遷新址，本建築被臺北市政府指定為古蹟。校史常設展主題包含：臺大精神與象徵、臺北帝大與臺大之大事紀、各學院榮耀與成就、社會關懷與校園生活、檢討與反省、校區分布與校園變遷等等。

校史館設立後，致力於本校自臺北帝大（包含前身）迄今豐厚人文歷史的探究，史料文物與老照片徵集、口述歷史訪談；校史相關的特展與活動策畫、書籍出版、文創品開發，以延續本校記憶、凝聚向心力並傳承其精神。

NTU History Gallery is located on the 2nd floor of NTU's Old Main Library Building, at the site of previous central reading room. Operated by the University Library, the Gallery was opened to the public on June 22, 2005 with a permanent display of university history; while the "Chuan Lyu Exhibition Hall" for special exhibits was opened on November 15, 2007, the university anniversary. The building itself was built in 1929 during the Taihoku Imperial University period, and has undergone five phases of construction and expansion. When current University Main Library was established and vacated in 1998, it was designated a listed building by Taipei City Government. Topics on permanent display include: university spirit and symbols, the chronology of the university and its predecessors, the academic achievements, services to society, campus life, criticism and reflection, and evolution of university campus, etc.

After its founding, the Gallery has endeavored to dig into NTU's rich history and cultural heritage since the Taihoku Imperial University and its predecessors, to collect archives, artifacts and old photographs, and to conduct oral history interviews. It also strives for curating special exhibitions, organizing events, publishing printed matters, and developing cultural and creative products, with an aim to keep on the collective memory, to promote identity, and to hand down the inherited spirit.

臺大人類學博物館位於舊總圖西翼，典藏許多珍貴的民族學與考古學文物。民族學主要承接自 1928 年臺北帝國大學「土俗人種學講座」標本室收藏；考古學收藏主要來自臺大人類學系田野課程或因研究而發掘出土或地表調查採集的臺灣各地史前遺址文物。礙於經費，目前僅開放「民族學展示廳」，「考古學展廳」仍在募款籌建中。

為盡社會使命，人類學博物館近年由專注研究轉型對公眾開放，並設定「部落合作」與「知識分享」兩大目標。透過年度部落合作策展，讓部落以自己的視角呈現自身文化傳統，使文物重新與部落產生新連結，並增進大眾對原住民文化的理解。博物館亦透過導覽、教育活動、國內外學者演講、和工作坊等，與大眾分享學者研究結果，促進知識流通與國際交流。



NTU Museum of Anthropology, located at the west wing of the Old Main Library Building, features ethnographic and archaeological artifacts of Taiwan collected by academic related activities of the University. The ethnographic holdings are mainly derived from the period of the Institute of Ethnology of the Taihoku Imperial University (the predecessor of NTU). The archaeological holdings are obtained from excavations and surface collections by NTU fieldwork courses or research projects. Currently only the "Ethnology Hall" opens publicly since the museum still raises money for the "Archaeology Hall."

Since 2010, the museum has transformed from an academic facility into a place devoting to public services. The core values of the museum are "cooperating with indigenous peoples" and "knowledge sharing." The museum sets up annual collaborative special exhibitions with indigenous peoples to show their cultures to the public from their perspectives and reconnect the artifacts with the source groups. The museum also increases the accessibility of the artifacts via exhibitions, education activities, etc. and shares anthropological knowledge by developing public workshops and lectures.

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臺大地質標本館建於 1937 年臺北帝國大學時代，位於地質科學系館旁，內部屋樑以臺灣檜木為材料，屋脊上的圓柱型天窗、黑瓦及兩旁的五邊型長窗是典型的日式建築特色。標本館藏有大量珍貴的典藏標本，包括化石標本、礦物標本、岩石標本，總數超過 3,500 件以上。館內展示櫃擺放了歷年收藏的標本，並以數位櫥的方式展示這些價值匪淺的標本。此外，館內不定期舉辦不同主題的展覽，從探討臺灣地質環境到地質系研究成果展，將地質科學轉變成生活化的知識，期許透過這些展覽能讓民眾更了解我們居住的環境，激起「生於斯，長於斯」的愛鄉情懷。



NTU Geo-specimen Cottage, built in 1937 at the time of Taihoku Imperial University, stands independently next to Department of Geosciences. The Cottage's tiled roof, vents, attic (built with Taiwan Hinoki) and the pentagonal windows are all Japanese style. The Cottage stores numerous specimens of rocks, minerals, fossils and other geology-related pieces collected in Taiwan and around the world, more than 3,500 in total. Items on display will change irregularly depending on the topic. By displaying specimens to the public, we explain the basics of Geology and invite visitors to understand Taiwan in a brand new perspective.

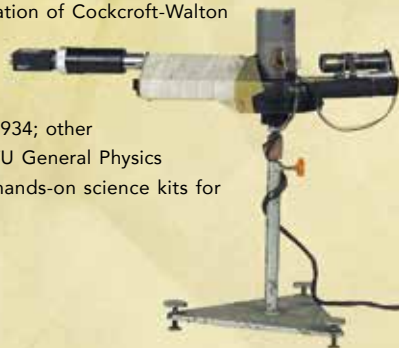

臺大物理文物廳位於校總區二號館一樓，包含有原子核物理展示廳、普物實驗展示廳、科學走廊，以及早期實驗儀器展示室。原子核物理展示廳所展示的 Cockcroft-Walton 型直線加速器，係承繼 1934 年荒勝文策教授於臺北帝國大學所完成的亞洲首次原子核撞擊實驗所留下的基礎，於 1948 年重建而成，在臺灣科學發展史上，扮演重要的角色。普物實驗展示廳與早期實驗儀器展示室，則展示臺大物理系普物實驗課程歷年來所使用的教學儀器、工具，並提供科學教具供參觀者操作，使參觀團體能親身體驗物理學的樂趣，寓教於樂。

NTU Heritage Hall of Physics is located in the No.2 Building, including Nuclear Physics section, showrooms of General Physics experiments and early time instruments, and the Gallery of Science. The Nuclear Physics section displays the first generation of Cockcroft-Walton linear accelerator built by the NTU Department of Physics in 1948, which was on the basis of the successful and significant nucleus-cracking experiment accomplished by Professor Bunsaku Arakatsu at Taihoku Imperial University in 1934; other showrooms display the old apparatuses handmade by the NTU General Physics Laboratory from the late-1940s to recent time. We provide hands-on science kits for visiting groups to explore, making learning fun and engaging.

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臺大昆蟲標本館成立於 1936 年，是目前國內昆蟲標本蒐藏中最具歷史意義的典藏資產，其中不乏百年以上之老標本與無數珍貴標本。本館標本蒐藏源自 19 世紀初期，除了典藏日治時代以及光復後的標本外，1980 年開始，在國家科學委員會的支持下，昆蟲學系師生積極展開臺灣昆蟲相調查，使得昆蟲標本數量激增。本館蒐藏之標本超過 33 萬個體，依性質可概分為模式標本、研究標本、教學標本、展示標本四類。臺大昆蟲標本館豐富又珍貴的昆蟲標本蒐藏，是臺灣昆蟲學發展重要的文化資產。

NTU Insect Museum was established in 1936, and its collection has become a historical treasure with important components from Taiwan, among which are specimens preserved for over a century and numerous invaluable specimens. The beginning of specimen collection can be traced back to the early nineteen century. Apart from the continuously accumulation since the period of Japanese colonial and post-war period, after 1980 the National Science Council also began to support faculty members and students of the Department of Entomology for a comprehensive insect survey in Taiwan, which contributes the sudden surge of the number of specimens. With over 330,000 specimens in our collection, the specimens can be classified into four categories: type specimen, research specimen, teaching specimen and display specimen. Nowadays, the historical treasure of NTU Insect Museum has kept on leading the progress of Entomological research in Taiwan.

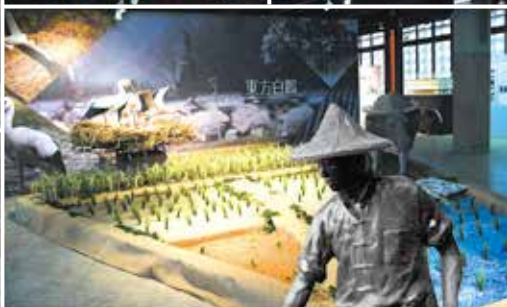

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臺灣光復後，政府勵精圖治，積極實施一系列土地改革政策，解決了農業發展的基本問題，改善了農民的生活。故陳誠副總統與農復會主委故蔣夢麟博士，有感於臺灣農業發展之成就，遂促成「農業陳列館」於1964年落成啟用。其後為配合國家農業發展與農村社會變遷，本館不斷更新展覽主題與內容。此外，本館為一棟三層樓之歷史建築，建築設計手法創新，為張肇康建築師之中國現代建築高峰之作，現已獲臺北市認定為市定歷史建物，展現了中西建築思維的激盪與融合，在臺灣建築史上佔有重要地位。時至今日，農業陳列館繼續扮演農業推廣與創新傳播之服務功能，包括透過辦理展覽、教育訓練、工作坊、演講、座談會與研討會等方法，進行相關生態農業、食農教育、農村文化與跨域傳播之服務，並提供師生同仁及社會大眾作為創新思考與學習體驗的開放場域，開啟農業陳列館服務社會的推廣教育新頁。

Since the retrocession of Taiwan to the Republic of China, the successful implementation of the land reform program has solved fundamental problems of agriculture and improved farmers' living. The late Vice President Chen Cheng of the Republic of China, and Dr. Chiang Mon-Lin, the late Chairman of the Sino-American Joint Commission on Rural Reconstruction (JCRR) recognized agricultural development in Taiwan as an excellent model for developing countries. Therefore, the Agricultural Exhibition Hall was built in 1964 to demonstrate this success. Since then, the exhibition content has been renewed and changed many times in response to the progress of agricultural and rural developments. In addition, this three-floor building, now registered as a historic building by Taipei City Government, was designed by the architect Chao-Kan Chang, a paragon who led the modernization of Chinese architecture marking the infusion of traditional and modern style with classical taste, innovative design, pragmatic function and a crucial position in the history of Taiwan's architecture. Today, the Hall continues to function as a service provider for agricultural extension and innovation communication, including eco-agriculture, food and agriculture education, rural culture and interdisciplinary communication through exhibition, education and training, workshop, lecture, symposium and seminar service. The Hall is an open field of exhibition for stakeholders and public as an innovative thinking and learning experience. It activates its diverse social and educational function and opens a new page of the extension education for social servicing.

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臺大植物標本館位在一號館與女五宿舍之間，包含標本館、烤房、日治時期庭園、臺北濕地植物區、蕨園及一棟臺大早期的玻璃溫室。植物標本館除了典藏研究標本之外，館內一樓並設置展示區，包含常設展區、民族植物區、浸液標本區，以及定期換展的特展區。常設展區中，不僅有珍貴植物標本的介紹，也有標本製作的流程和相關書籍的展示。

植物標本館創立於 1929 年。成立以來即不斷在臺灣及其鄰近地區——如東南亞、太平洋島嶼等地進行植物調查與採集，為目前研究臺灣與東南亞植物資源的重要機構。本館也經常與國外約 150 個相關機構互相交流與交換標本，館藏標本十分豐富多樣，數量達 35 萬份以上，除包含植物學上最珍貴的模式標本 1,200 餘份，此外，更具特色的是擁有 1950 年以前採集具高研究價值的歷史珍藏標本六萬餘份。

NTU Herbarium (abbreviation TAI) is located between the No.1 Building and the 5th Girl's Dormitory, and includes the main Herbarium building, a oven house, a small Japanese style garden, a Taipei wetland corner, a fern garden, and a historical greenhouse. The herbarium building contains an exhibition area in addition to the specimen storage. The first floor houses exhibitions of the General Exhibition Room, the Ethnobotany Room, the Spirit Collection Room, and a Special Exhibition Room for various subjects. Many precious specimens and other collections from NTU herbarium are demonstrated.

Founded in 1929, TAI has been the frontier for plant surveys not only in Taiwan, but also in the surrounding regions like Southeast Asia and the Pacific Islands. Currently TAI has more than 350,000 specimens, including 1200+ invaluable type specimens, and continuously exchanging specimens with over 150 foreign research institutes for enriching collections. In addition, over 60,000 specimens were collected before 1950, providing abundant historical records on Taiwan's indigenous flora.

自 1928 年成立於臺北帝國大學時期，臺大動物博物館紀錄了臺灣及鄰近地區豐富的動物相。發展至今，已從單純的研究典藏機構轉型為支持大學研究、教學及科普的大學博物館，不僅珍藏著許多重要歷史價值的標本，也包括與動物分類、生態與演化有關的研究標本與記錄。

「雙重解剖」特展位於生命科學館一樓，展出來自窗殺、路殺及魚獲採集的標本。這些標本不僅提供研究資料，透過多樣化的製作和保存方式，如毛皮、組織到透明標本，展現了標本在教育 and 不同主題研究中的多功能性，觀眾不僅能近距離觀察標本的細節，也能深入瞭解標本背後的故事。

NTU Museum of Zoology was established in 1928 during the Japanese colonial period, dedicated to documenting the rich fauna of Taiwan and its neighboring regions. Over the decades, it has evolved from a purely research-oriented collection facility into a university museum that supports research, teaching, and public outreach. The museum preserves many specimens of significant historical value and encompasses a diverse range of animal taxonomical and ecological research.

The "Dual Dissection" special exhibition, located on the first floor of the Life Sciences Building, displays specimens from various sources, such as window collisions, road kills, and fish by-catches. These specimens provide valuable data for scientific research and, through diverse preparation techniques like taxidermy, necropsy, and diaphonization, demonstrate the multifunctionality of specimens in education and research. To learn more about the beauty and complexity of animal specimens, visitors are invited to observe the intricate details of the specimens and delve into the stories behind them.

臺大檔案自 1945 年累積迄今，記載臺灣大學學術發展的事蹟，典藏臺大人辛勤耕耘的軌跡，於 2007 年 8 月搬遷至水源校區飲水樓後，成立檔案展示室，2015 年 7 月升級成為全國大學第一座跨領域的檔案館。展示主軸為：「從檔案中洞觀歷史，在檔案中品味藝術」，並在檔案科學管理的基礎上，建構三大發展平台：(1) 檔案展示：呈現公文稿裡的校園人文故事，拓展聯合展示的交流與跨界藝術的激盪；(2) 檔案修護：修護各類破損的校內外重要文件，蒐集傳統手工技術檔案，延伸發展檔案志工手工創意藝術平台；(3) 檔案文創：結合檔案元素與學生創意加值應用，展售校園文創紀念品，推廣臺大精粹的人文精神。檔案館在融合資訊科技與專業技術創新運用下，將展現 21 世紀多元文化價值的新風貌與新意象。

NTU Archives has been recorded the academic development on NTU and the effort of NTU members since 1945. It was moved to Shuiyuan campus with a new exhibition room in August 2007, and upgraded to be the country's first interdisciplinary university Archives in July 2015.

Display spindle: "By Archives Insight History From Archives Enjoy Aesthetic". Based on the scientific management, Archives constructed three platforms: (1)Exhibition: Official documents tell the story of humanities; Expanding the communication of transboundary art (2) Restoring: Restoring all kinds of damaged files; Collecting traditional manual techniques; Developing of volunteers with manual & creative works (3) Souvenirs: Integrating Cultural & Creative elements; Students also join the design team; Selling cultural souvenirs; Promoting the essence of the human spirit. 醫學人文博物館位於醫學校區，館舍建於1907-1913年，由近藤十郎所設計，採用法國風格後期文藝復興樣式。本館之保存與修復，以注入人文精神於古蹟建築為主，並彰顯其長期伴隨臺灣本土醫學教育及醫療發展的珍貴歷史價值。啟用後，主要做為本院醫學人文教育、醫學文物展示及校友師生交誼之中心。

館內的展示主題包括：臺大醫學院120週年院慶展「上醫醫國」、臺大醫學院的寄生蟲與蛇毒研究、郵票上的醫療照護、演化與人、臺灣衛生醫療發展、高齡社會健康照護藍圖2.0。希望藉由本館展示內容，發揮教育功能，除了期盼能夠激勵本院師生，傳承醫學院景福校友精神，也期待引導一般民眾、學生，從生理、心理、社會等各面向對於「人」這個主體，有更全面性的關注與理解，並建立以人為中心的關懷精神與文化。

Located at the Downton campus, NTU Museum of Medical Humanities is housed in a building complex built up between 1907 and 1913. The architecture was designed by Mr. Kondo Juro adopting the French architectural style of the late Renaissance period.

In order to preserve the building, there was a reconstruction in 1995. The preservation and reconstruction of Medical Humanities building is in honor of the humanistic spirit and the precious historical value of the local Taiwan medical science development. The Medical Humanities building has become the center for medical humanities education, the exhibition of medical culture artifacts, as well as social center for alumni, faculty members and students.

The current exhibitions include:

- "The special exhibition for the 120th anniversary of NTUCM – The best doctor heals the country",
- "The NTUCM researchers on parasites and snake venom",
- "Postage stamps about medical care",
- "Evolution and humankind",
- "The development of public health and infectious disease management in Taiwan",
- "The blueprint of geriatric care for a healthy aged society".

We expect that the exhibitions will encourage students to learn from respectful doctors and alumni of NTUCM across generations, carry on valuable traditions, and bring into full play of its potential educational function. Through biopsychosocial approach with a more holistic and comprehensive way, the exhibition will lead the audience to understand and care about human beings and human welfare.

藝術史研究所於 2017 年成立臺大美術館籌備處，並於 2021 年正式加入臺大博物館群，與其他已設立館所交流借鑑，共同整合校園文化性資產及藏品，提供教學資源。

美術館籌備處設立以來，除空間規劃與策畫展覽外，整理、擴充館藏亦是重要工作。多方努力下，目前館藏已有由師生、校友、私人藏家、海外知名學者及基金會捐贈或寄存之書畫、陶瓷文物、標本、書籍、手稿等，具重要藝術與學術價值。未來擬以古代文物、藝術品、標本及檔案資料為主要典藏方向，並拓展至現當代藝術品。

國立臺灣大學藝術史研究所美術館於 2023 年 5 月 31 日正式揭牌啟用，第一檔展覽亦同時開幕。美術館以「藝術品」和包括研究者、策展人、參觀者、學生和藝術家在內的「人」為核心，進行研究／實驗、教育／學習及互惠／合作的場域。未來將秉持這樣原則，持續策畫展覽，促進校內人文藝術風氣；並與教學結合，提供實務課程學習資源，逐步發展為一流大學美術館。

The Graduate Institute of Art History established the NTU Art Museum Preparatory Office in 2017. In 2021, the Art Museum Preparatory Office officially joined the NTU Museums, exchanged and interacted with other member museums on campus, integrated campus cultural heritages and collections, and provided teaching resources.

After establishing the Art Museum Preparatory Office, in addition to spatial planning and curating exhibitions, organizing and expanding collections have also been essential tasks. After all efforts, the collection currently includes paintings, calligraphy, ceramic relics, educational specimens, books, and manuscripts donated and deposited by faculty members and students, alumni, private collectors, well-known overseas scholars, and foundations, all of which have significant artistic and academic reference value. In the future, the Art Museum will focus on ancient artifacts, artworks, specimens, and archival materials and expand to modern and contemporary artworks.

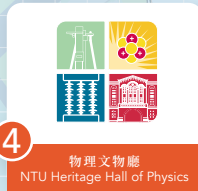

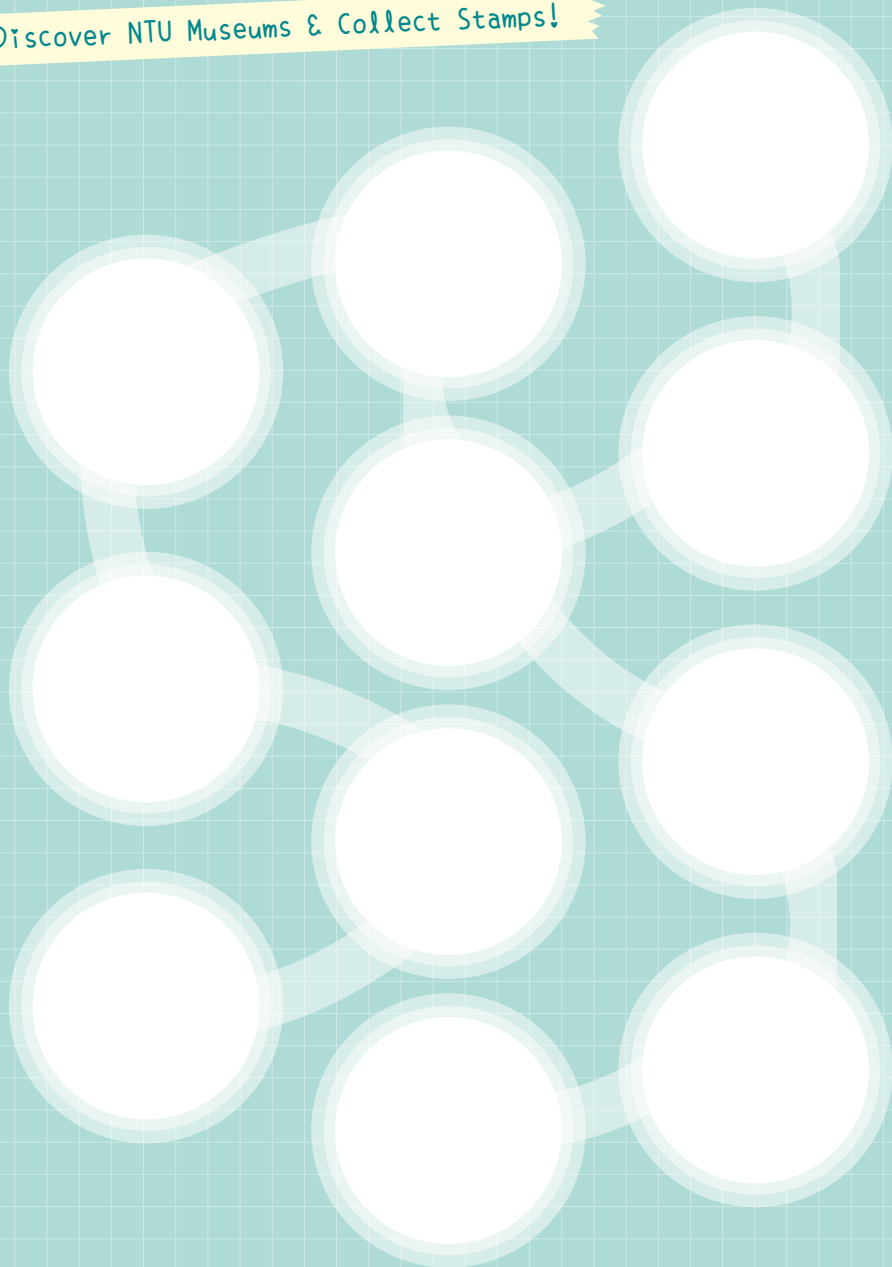

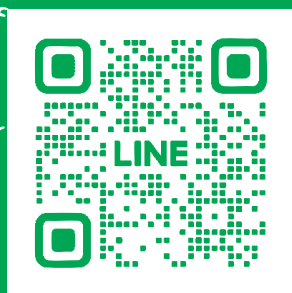
