British Periodicals

British Periodicals Collection I & II collect 472 titles which includes the most famous periodicals and lesser known journalistic “undergrowth” from the 17th through the early 20th centuries.

Subsequently, Collection III & IV, a total of 18 important journals with large circulation and longevity, were launched, reflecting the changes in British history and culture in the first half of the 20th century, covering politics, news, culture and society, cultural and historical development.



British Periodicals

Whole collection contains 491 journals published between 1681 and 1929, totaling 6.1 million pages, divided into four parts:

Collection I : 162 journals

Collection II : 310 journals

Collection III : 8 journals

Collection IV: 10 Journals

Collection I – Early British Periodicals covering history, literature, slavery, psychology, science, religion and folk culture, etc.

Notable publications include:-

- **Gentleman's Magazine**: Founded in 1731, Gentleman's Magazine is the first publication published in the name of a magazine in modern times. The full content completely preserved.
- **Anti-Slavery Reporter** and other anti-slavery publications, providing first-hand accounts, reports of British parliamentary proceedings and speeches made by anti-slavery groups at the time.
- Various religious journals such as **Methodist Magazine** and **Jewish Quarterly Review**.

Collection II – A digital collection of documents indispensable for reflecting the social development in the 18th and 19th centuries, in which famous thinkers and writers published articles or editors on topics. Covering literature , music, art, drama, archaeology and architecture.

THE Pacific Coast of Asia is in some respects the most interesting in the world. From Kamtchatka to Australia we have one long series of great island groups along the coast, and among them multitudes of islets looking on the map as if they had been scattered from a Titanic pepper-box. If the great waves of the broad Pacific have had little to do with the breaking up into fragments of the eastern border of Asia, there seems no doubt, that it is connected with the seismic forces which we find everywhere prevalent from Behring Sea to Java. Professor Judd tells us, that one hundred and fifty volcanoes exist in the chain of islands which stretch from Behring Straits down to the Antarctic circle; and, if we include the volcanoes in the Indian and Pacific Islands which appear to be situated in lines branching

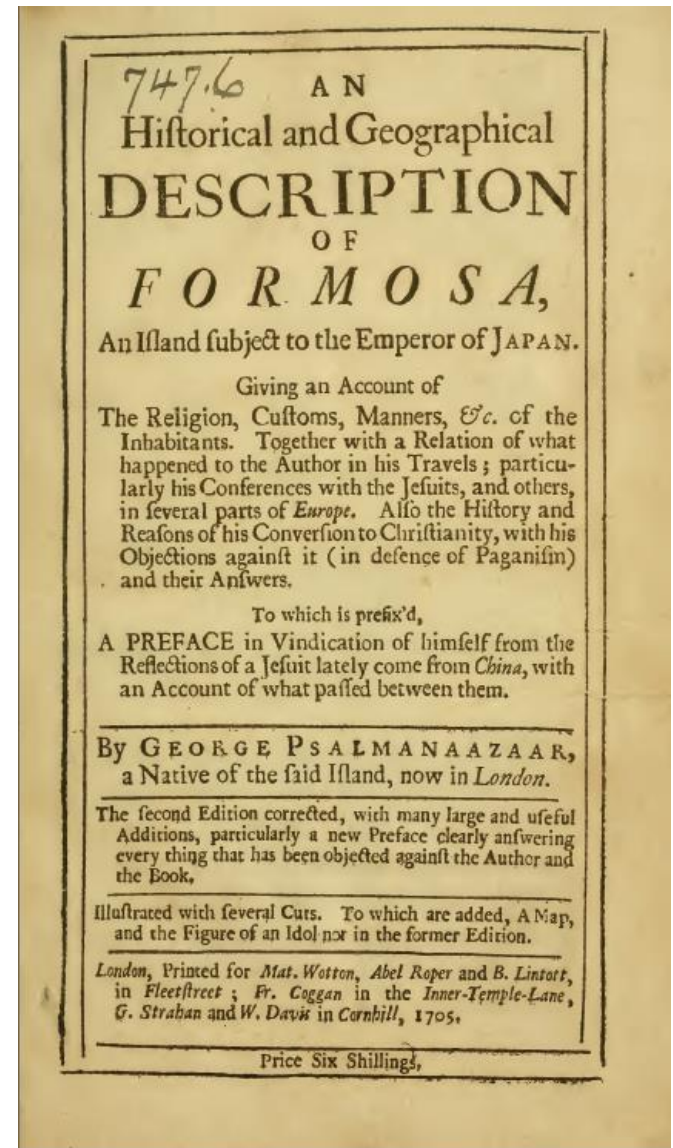

ProQuest and the National Security Archive have launched the Digital National Security Archive (DNSA).

It is a massive database of over 140,000 declassified files (more than 875,000 pages) covering U.S. foreign policy and national security decisions from 1945 to 2016. Organized into 61 specific topics, the archive features: **Declassified Communications:** Presidential orders, government memos, meeting minutes, briefings, White House correspondence, and secret emails/letters. **Helpful Context:** Expert introductions, timelines, and glossaries for each topic to help easily make sense of the history.

Asia research (12 collections)

Afghanistan: The Making of U.S. Policy, 1973-1990 美國對阿富汗政策

This collection includes 2,326 documents—roughly 15,000 pages—focused on the Soviet military occupation between 1979 and 1988. It also covers the buildup to the 1979 invasion and the withdrawal of Soviet forces in 1988-1989.

The Philippines: U.S Policy during the Marcos Years, 1965-1986

Offering a look into controversial U.S. alliances, this part tracks the conflicts of interest between different U.S. administrations and President Marcos of the Philippines.

U.S. Nuclear History, 1969-1976: Weapons, Arms Control, and War Plans in an Age of Strategic Parity

•Filled with past top-secret government files, this collection includes program directives, requirements studies, and other records showing exactly how the U.S. military space program evolved over time.

European and Africa (4 collections)

The Berlin Crisis, 1958-1962 柏林危機

•Focusing on the high-stakes Berlin standoff under Presidents Eisenhower and Kennedy, this collection documents what was the most enduring crisis of the entire Cold War.

Focusing on the main pillars of the U.S.–South Africa relationship, this collection features documents on the arms embargo, nuclear collaboration, economic sanctions, and various regional conflicts.

Often seen as the most dangerous moment of the Cold War, the Cuban Missile Crisis is documented here in incredible detail. This collection brings together 15,000 pages of rare, high-level government files that offer an unmatched look at the crisis.

Cuban Missile Crisis Revisited: An International Collection of Documents, from the Bay of Pigs to the Brink of Nuclear War

•Highlighting a key era in U.S.–Latin American relations, this collection tracks American policy and events from the Carter administration's new approach in Central America through the rise of President Duarte in El Salvador.

El Salvador: War, Peace, and Human Rights, 1980-1994

•Following up on earlier files, these declassified records on El Salvador highlight several human rights incidents that became central to the United Nations Truth Commission's investigation.

Documenting Nicaragua's shift in the 1980s across politics, the military, and the economy, this collection covers what was easily the most debated and divisive U.S. foreign policy of that decade.

Death Squads, Guerrilla War, Covert Operations, and Genocide: Guatemala and the U.S., 1954-1999 敢死隊、游擊戰、策反行動

Tracking the relationship between the U.S. and Guatemala, this collection covers the 1954 CIA-backed coup and the decades of civil war that followed in its wake.

•Providing a rare look through the eyes of U.S. diplomats and intelligence officers in Lima, this collection tracks Peru's civil war and the increasingly autocratic rule of three different governments.

Providing a deep dive into America's involvement in Chile, this collection includes files on CIA-backed missions, the coup, the crackdown under the Pinochet regime, and international terrorism.

•This collection serves as a case study for how the U.S. handled its relationships with controversial allies, specifically tracking the clashing interests between U.S. officials and President Marcos over the years.

Focusing on a key U.S. priority in the region, this collection tracks American policy as it grappled with Argentina's descent into tragedy—from the government's collapse and the threat of civil war to the eventual military coup.

Tracking the history of the war on drugs between the U.S. and Mexico, this collection starts with President Nixon's 'Operation Intercept,' where the U.S. essentially closed the border to crack down on marijuana trafficking. ◦

Middle East Collections (4 collections)

Iran: The Making of U.S. Policy, 1977-1980 美國對伊朗政策

•Covering the most turbulent years in Iran, this collection tracks American policy and the ground-level chaos between January 20, 1977, and January 29, 1980.

The Iran-Contra Affair: The Making of a Scandal, 1983-1988 伊朗門事件

Prior to 1977:

The United States and Iran first established diplomatic relations **in** 1856. However, aside from two important U.S. economic advisory missions sent to Iran **in** 1910-1911 and 1922-1927, contact between the two countries before World War II consisted mainly of missionary and archaeological activity and a limited amount of trade. The Allied powers invaded and occupied Iran during World War II **in** order to establish a supply route to the Soviet Union, removing the pro-German Reza Shah **in** the process. Tens of thousands of American soldiers were stationed **in** Iran during the war **in** connection with the supply operation, providing extensive contact between the two countries for the first time. The United States also sent another economic advisory mission to Iran and began to train and equip Iran's armed forces and Gendarmerie during World War II.
