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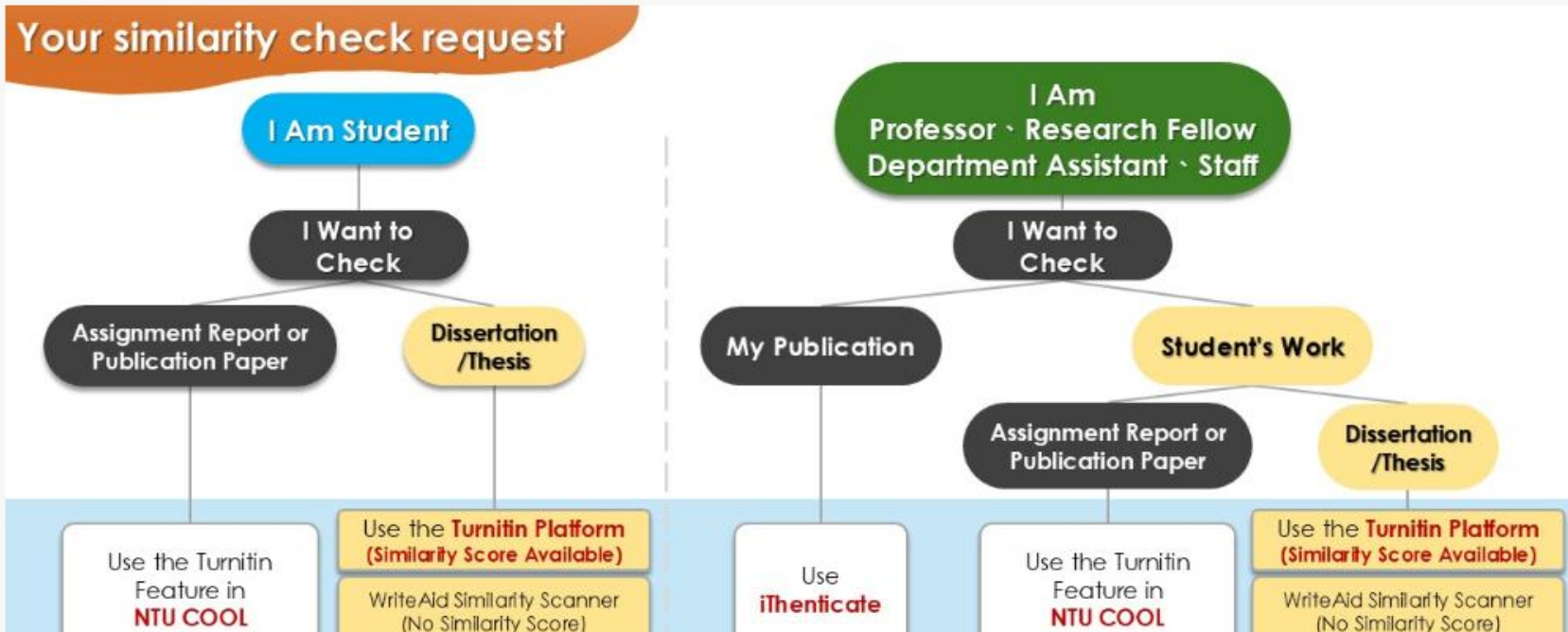
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■ Introduction

Once students receive the course invitation email and activate their accounts, they can log in to the Turnitin platform to conduct the originality comparison and obtain the similarity report.

2. Before submitting the master's thesis or Ph.D. dissertation, students must proceed a comparison of originality for their thesis or dissertation.
