About Open Access (OA)

Open Access means making publications freely available online with limited restrictions based on "Open License". The 2 main ways of publishing OA are:



About "Open License"

It means "Some Rights Reserved". The most common copyright scheme for "Open License" is "Creative Commons (CC)", which contains 6 types of licenses created from the various combinations of 4 license elements. When an OA article is published, the author is obliged to choose the license, so as to protect his/her corresponding right to share the work.



Main types of OA journals

Direct OA journals: All articles are freely available online.

Hybrid OA journals: These are subscription journals in which OA publishing options are provided.

Beware of Predatory Journals

Predatory publishers abuse the OA author-pays model for their own profit. They charge authors Article Processing Charges (APC) but fail to meet scholarly publishing standards, like peer review. Please refer to the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) before you submit. All journals collected in DOAJ follow principles of transparency and best practice in scholarly publishing, which makes DOAJ a legitimate reference in qualifying journals.

APC-free publishing in Cambridge University Press OA Journals

Authors in NTU can publish in the OA journals of Cambridge University Press without paying APC, starting from 2021. Application Requirements:

- 1. The article must be published in Cambridge University Press OA journals.
- The corresponding author must be affiliated with National Taiwan University.
- The article must be accepted after Jan. 1st, 2021. The author has to complete application for APC funding.


